Food Vendor Application 2008 ARTASTIC Children's Art Festival Saturday, October 4th 10am- 3pm

Commercial 20 x 20 space = \$125 ~ Non-profit 20 x 20 space = \$100

- Vendors using canopies must have proof the canopy is treated with fireproof chemicals. Vendors using warming or cooking devices must have a charged fire extinguisher & current inspection sticker (min. 10-15 lbs. dry powder or CO2) visible in booth. Fire Marshall will check ALL vendors.
- **Alcoholic beverages may NOT be sold by vendors.**
- You must attach menu (including beverages) with prices to your application and will only be allowed to sell the items on that menu. **No less than 2 menus with prices MUST be posted at all times.** (Minimum size 8.5 x 11)
- We ask that food vendors offer a significant discount to city employees that are in uniform and on duty (parks & recreation, police, EMT, Fire, Rescue, Sanitation, etc.).
- Direct water hookup will be provided; you must furnish all your own food grade hoses (LENGTH will

depend on location assigned). You must furnish gray water disposal containers if necessary. Vendors may share disposal container.

NO GREASE IS TO BE DUMPED INTO CONTAINERS. ANY VENDOR SEEN DUMPING GREASE INTO CONTAINER WILL PAY A PENALTY OF \$200 AND WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN THIS EVENT AGAIN.

- **NOTHING** IS TO BE Poured INTO STREET, STORM DRAIN OR ON SIDEWALK.

All Food Vendors must abide by NC Health guidelines and will be inspected prior to opening. For more information contact Cumberland County Health Department at 910-433-3660

- **Electricity** : Electrical hookups may not be available. Quiet generators are permitted.

Concession ONLY

- "Concession only" is defined as a commercial or non-profit food vendor selling pre-packaged food items ONLY
10 x 10 space = \$95
10 x 10 space = \$70 non-profit

General Vendor Information

All Vendors **MUST**:

- Complete and sign application including payment by check or money order made payable to "The Fayetteville Museum of Art"
- Include self-addressed stamped envelope with application (#10 envelope stamped with \$.42)
- **All vendors must provide a list of their items, photos and price range (photos cannot be returned). Vendors will not be allowed to sell items not listed with their application.**
- Provide booth supplies (canopy, tables, chairs, etc.)
- Be responsible for their own insurance policies.
- Be responsible for collecting and reporting any applicable taxes (local, state and federal).
- Vendors will be notified by mail of acceptance. FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE ONCE A VENDOR HAS BEEN ACCEPTED. FMOA reserves the right to reject applications and return booth fees.
- All dimensions are OUTSIDE dimensions. Booths will only be sold in the dimensions listed but you may purchase multiple spaces. If purchasing multiple spaces the set up is determined by NEW fire code regulations. Please inquire for further explanation.
- This event is located outside in downtown Fayetteville, in Festival Park and is a rain or shine event.
- All vendor booths should be attractive from all sides and not distract from the booth next to you.
- Spaces will be assigned by the committee and will be released at check-in.
- Check-in time, directions to the event and sign-in location will be provided once your application has been approved.
- Non-profits MUST provide documentation of 501 status with application and payment must be on corporate check.
- Gates open at 10:00 am and the event concludes at 3:00 pm.

The Fayetteville Museum of Art reserves the right to provide exclusive vending privileges to event sponsors.
